## Ambassador of Hungary Imre Laszlóczki talks to ENU students about his country's foreign policy and relations with Kazakhstan

ASTANA – The next lecture under the initiative "A Bridge of Friendship between the EU and ENU" will be delivered by His Excellency the Hungarian Ambassador Imre Laszlóczki on 11 April 2011 at the Gumilyov Eurasian National University (ENU). Ambassador of Hungary to the Republic of Kazakhstan, Mr. Laszlóczki will deliver a lecture on "The Foreign Policy of the Republic of Hungary during its chairmanship in the Council of the European Union."

The lecture will consist of the three parts dedicated to:

- 1. The foreign policy of the Republic of Hungary;
- 2. The chairmanship of Hungary in the EU Council;
- 3. Bilateral relations between Hungary and Kazakhstan.

The ENU's faculty members, undergraduate and graduate students, Ph.D. students will have the opportunity to ask their questions and to use the provided information in their research work.

The initiative "A Bridge of Friendship between the EU and ENU" started on 24 November 2010 with a first conference by Ambassador Norbert Jousten, Head of the Delegation of the European Union to the Republic of Kazakhstan. As of today, the Ambassadors of the following EU Member States delivered their speeches: Latvia, Slovakia, Greece, Spain, Germany, Finland and Czech Republic. The following Heads of Missions confirmed that they will give their lecture during the current academic year: Sweden, the United Kingdom, Romania, Lithuania, France, Italy, the Netherlands, Belgium, and Poland. The lectures are on various aspects of life in the European Union and its Member States.
